Event Supplementary Regulations

These Event Supplementary Regulations are to be read together with the 2019 SEAC TRE Series Regulations

1. THE EVENT

- 1.1. The Event shall be known as the “2019 LCORC Rally Sprint” (hereafter referred to as the Event) will be a round of the 2019 SEAC TRE Series and will be conducted at Moorex Park Property.
- 1.2. The length of the rally will be approximately 45 kms, including 6 stages which have a total competitive distance of approximately 30 kms. All special stages are of a sand/dirt surface, held on private property.
- 1.3. The Event is a **Club Stage 1 (S1) Rally Sprint**.

- 3.2. This Event will be conducted under and in accordance with CAMS OH&S, CAMS Safety 1st and Risk Management Policies, which can be found on the CAMS website at www.cams.com.au.
- 3.3. Certain public, property, professional indemnity and personal accident insurance is provided by CAMS in relation to the Event. Further details can be found in the CAMS Insurance Handbook, available at www.cams.com.au.

- 3.4. The CAMS Permit Number **519/2206/01** authorising this Event, and will be displayed on the Official Notice Board.
- 3.5. Where there is any divergence between the current CAMS Manual of Motor Sport, the Series' Regulations and the Event Supplementary Regulations, the Event Supplementary Regulations will take precedence.

7. CREW ELIGIBILITY

- 7.1. Crews shall comprise of either one or two persons both being the holders of a minimum CAMS

Level 2S(J) licence. The minimum age for Drivers and Co-Drivers in Rally Sprints is 14 years. Please note that Junior Drivers will need an experienced Co-Driver and approval from the Clerk of the Course prior to commencing competition.

7.2. Maximum number of Drivers per vehicle will be 2.

8. ENTRIES AND ENTRY FEE

8.1. The Entry Fee for the Event is fixed as follows:

- \$80.00 for LCORC members
- \$110.00 for non-members

- Entries may be refused in accordance with NCR 83 of the current CAMS Manual.

9. SCRUTINY

9.1. Scrutiny will be performed between 8.00am – 9.00am on Saturday 22nd June outside of Rally headquarters at Moorex property.

9.2. No late scrutineering will be done.

9.3. At Scrutineering Competitors will be required to present:

- Vehicle Log Book (if issued to vehicle)
- Helmets
- The car in a “ready to rally” condition, including driving lights (if they will be used).

9.4. Vehicles must arrive at the Scrutiny Venue in **READY TO COMPETE CONDITION** in compliance with Schedule A and Schedule NRC VG, of the current CAMS Manual of Motor Sport.

9.5. Apparel, including helmets, shall comply with Schedule D of the current CAMS Manual.

10. DOCUMENTATION

10.1. The following items shall be presented and checked by both Driver and Co-Driver at Scrutiny:

- Current LCORC membership card
- Both Current CAMS Competition Licence,

10.2. CAMS Vehicle Log Book (if issued to vehicle)

11. SERVICING AND REFUELLING

11.1. Servicing is only allowed in the designated service area as indicated on the day.

11.2. The maximum distance between refuelling will be approximately 8.0km competitive.

11.3. Re-fuelling is only allowed in the designated re-fuel area.

11.4. There is no fuel available the Event.

12. ALCOHOL, DRUGS AND OTHER SUBSTANCES

Any holder of a CAMS ‘Competition’ or ‘Officials’ licence (or equivalent licence issued by another ASN) may be tested for the presence of drugs (or other banned substances) and subject to a penalty(ies) for a breach in accordance with the CAMS Anti-Doping Policy and/or the CAMS Illicit Drugs in Sport (Safety Testing) Policy as published on the CAMS website. Consumption of alcohol in the paddock, pits or any section of the competition venue/course under the control of the Officials is forbidden until all competition is concluded each day. Accordingly, any holder of a CAMS ‘Competition’ or ‘Officials’ licence (or equivalent licence issued by another ASN) may also be tested for the presence of alcohol by a CAMS

Accredited Testing Official (CATO) in accordance with the CAMS Standard Operating Procedure for Breath Alcohol Testing.

13. ALTERATION TO, ABANDONMENT OR TERMINATION OF THE EVENT

Event Organisers reserve the right to cancel, abandon or postpone the event in accordance with NCR 59 of the current CAMS Manual.

14. COMPETITORS BRIEFING

Competitors Briefing will be held at 9.15am. All Competitors are reminded that they must present themselves for Drivers Briefing. Penalty for non-attendance will result in Exclusion from the Event.

15. PROTESTS

Protests must be lodged in accordance with Part XII of the current CAMS Manual.

16. AWARDS

16.1. Trophies will be awarded to:

- Outright Placing for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd.
- 1st, 2nd and 3rd Novice Driver and Navigator

16.2. The Organisers reserve the right to combine trophies for winners and multiple awards.

16.3. Trophies will be presented at the 2019 SEAC presentation night.
