<p>TYRES</p>	<p>For Bitumen events tyres used are open but must not have canvas or steel showing. Spare tyres, which may be used during the event, shall be scrutinized along with the vehicle. Slick Tyres May change vehicle class in accordance to Supplementary regulations.</p>

EVENT COURSES & TESTS	Courses to be chosen from the Motorkhana test book and may include tests from VICTORIAN MOTORKHANA APPENDIX (14. Additional approved tests).
PASSENGERS	Junior competitors may request a Motorsport Australia Speed Licensed or superior. SEAC member as a passenger/instructor for the non-competitive component of the event. Approval must be given from the Clerk of the Course prior to any passenger entering a vehicle. Passengers must sign a "Passenger in Vehicle Disclaimer Form" (even if they are also a driver on the day) and comply with the supplementary regulations and current MSPRA requirements.
METHOD OF SCORING A handicap system will apply in 2022	S.A. & Victorian Motorkhana series will be Scored as per 2022 Motorsport Australia SA Motorkhana Championship Regulations & Scoring System & Standing regulations for the 2022 Motorsport Australia Victorian Motorkhana Championship. The handicap for SEAC scoring is applied before any penalties and is as follows: Class A, 0.90 Class B, 0.88 Class C, 0.86 Class D, 0.84 Class E, 0.92 Class F, no handicap Juniors and Novice Juniors will be handicapped on the car they are driving but will remain in the junior or novice junior class Competitors will be scored on 4 out of the 5 events. Your worst round will be dropped at the end of the season if you competed in all rounds in the 2022 series
VARIATIONS TO MOTORKHANA REGULATIONS:	(a) Clause 13.4 (viii) which deals with penalties for 'striking a marker', is varied with the addition of the words, "and significantly displaced from its original position". (b) Clause 13.4 (iv) that deals with reversing after crossing a designated finish line, the penalty is changed to "plus five seconds". (c) Every marker knocked carries a separate penalty of "plus 5 seconds". (d) Diagrams may be provided for each course.

Alcohol, Drugs and Other Substances

The holder of a Motorsport Australia Licence (or a Licence issued by another ASN) may be tested for the presence of any drug or other banned substance and subject to a penalty for a breach of the Australian National Anti-Doping Policy and/or the Motorsport Australia Illicit Drugs in Sport (Safety Testing) Policy at www.motorsport.org.au.

Consumption of alcohol in the paddock, pits or any other Reserved Area is prohibited until all Competition is concluded each day. The holder of a Motorsport Australia Licence (or a Licence issued by another ASN) may be tested for the presence of alcohol by a Motorsport Australia Accredited Testing Official (CATO) in accordance with the Motorsport Australia Alcohol Policy at www.motorsport.org.au.

COVID or other PANDEMICS:

South Eastern Automobile Club run Motorkhana Series 2022 will be following guidelines as issued by Federal and State Governments and Motorsport Australia (return to race) as the need arises. These may include but are not limited to, requirement to complete covid declaration form, sign in if required, abide by current physical distancing rules, don't attend if you are unwell, obey all directives given by officials. Whilst not a requirement yet it may be that you will need to be double vaccinated during the course of the year to compete. If this happens you will also be required to provide proof of your vaccination status.
