This Event will be conducted under and in accordance with Motorsport Australia OH&S, Safety 1<sup>st</sup>, Integrity & Legal and Risk Management Policies. <b>TYRES</b>	<p>For Bitumen events tyres used are open but must not have canvas or steel showing. Spare tyres, which may be used during the event, shall be scrutinized along with the vehicle.</p>
<b>VEHICLES WITHOUT WINDSCREENS</b>	<p>Drivers of vehicles without windscreens must wear appropriate eye-protection as per Motorsport Australia requirements and South Eastern Automobile Club Khanacross Series 2022 Standing Regulations</p>
<b>PASSENGERS</b>	<p>Junior competitors may request a Motorsport Australia Speed Licensed or superior. SEAC member as a passenger/instructor for the non-competitive component of the event. Approval must be given from the Clerk of the Course prior to any passenger entering a vehicle. Passengers must sign a "Passenger in Vehicle Disclaimer Form" (even if they are also a driver on the day) and comply with the supplementary regulations and current MSPRA requirements.</p>

<b>METHOD OF SCORING</b>	Placing's shall be decided on the aggregate of elapsed time on the tests completed, plus any penalties. The winner/s shall be the driver/s having the lowest aggregate, including any penalties, at the completion of the event. In the case of equal scores, the State Championship shall be decided using the Motorsport Australia championship and series policy, section 7, where the winner will be decided on a count back format.
<b>VARIATIONS TO KHANACROSS REGULATIONS:</b>	(a) Clause 13.4 (viii) which deals with penalties for 'striking a marker', is varied with the addition of the words, "and significantly displaced from its original position". (b) Clause 13.4 (iv) that deals with reversing after crossing a designated finish line, the penalty is changed to "plus five seconds". (c) Every marker knocked carries a separate penalty of "plus 5 seconds". (d) Diagrams may be provided for each course.
<b>The manner in which the results will be determined, and prizes awarded</b>	As per the South Eastern Automobile Club Standing Regulations, Standing regulations for the 2022 Motorsport Australia Victorian Khanacross Championship.
<b>SCHEDULE/ OTHER EVENT REQUIREMENTS</b>	Rotation of the field will be notified at the drivers briefing.
<b>CATERING</b>	Catering will be provided at the venue.

- No "Come and Try" will be offered at this event.
- The organisers may refuse any entry in accordance with NCR 33 of the Motorsport Australia Manual.
- Entries from competitors under 18 years of age must be counter signed/consented to by a parent/guardian.
- Event organisers reserve the right to cancel, abandon or postpone the event in accordance with NCR 11 of the Motorsport Australia Manual.
- Protests must be lodged in accordance with the NCR 94-99 of the Motorsport Australia Manual.

### **Alcohol, Drugs and Other Substances**

The holder of a Motorsport Australia Licence (or a Licence issued by another ASN) may be tested for the presence of any drug or other banned substance and subject to a penalty for a breach of the Australian National Anti-Doping Policy and/or the Motorsport Australia Illicit Drugs in Sport (Safety Testing) Policy at [www.motorsport.org.au](http://www.motorsport.org.au).

Consumption of alcohol in the paddock, pits or any other Reserved Area is prohibited until all Competition is concluded each day. The holder of a Motorsport Australia Licence (or a Licence issued by another ASN) may be tested for the presence of alcohol by a Motorsport Australia Accredited Testing Official (CATO) in accordance with the Motorsport Australia Alcohol Policy at [www.motorsport.org.au](http://www.motorsport.org.au).
