- Approved helmets and apparel, in accordance with Technical Appendix Schedule D of the Motorsport Australia Manual.
- Fuel must be in accordance with Technical Appendix Schedule G of the Motorsport Australia Manual.
- Cars must be adequately muffled.
- Competitors must produce a valid and current:
 - Motorsport Australia Competition Licence
 - Club Membership Card of a Motorsport Australia Affiliated Car Club
 - Log Book (if issued)

CLASSES	<p>CLASSES FOR SEAC 2026 Series</p> <p>Class A: Production cars 2WD wheelbase up to 2150mm</p> <p>Class B: Production cars 2WD wheelbase 2151mm - 2390mm</p> <p>Class C: Production cars 2WD wheelbase 2391mm - 2574mm</p> <p>Class D: Production cars 2WD wheelbase 2575 and over</p> <p>Class E: 4WD / AWD - must be driven in 4wd throughout competition</p> <p>Class F: Specials</p> <p>Class J: Juniors</p> <p>Class NJ: Novice Junior</p> <p>Class Master: Males 60+ and Females 55+ on 1st January 2026</p> <p>NOTES: Juniors are defined as being over 12 years but less than 18 years of age on the first day of the event</p> <p> Novices are defined as competitors in their first year of competition</p> <p> All persons driving a special will compete in the special Class F</p> <p> Competitors may compete in two vehicles in two classes provided they have paid two entry fees</p> <p> All Juniors and Novice Juniors will be handicap on the car they are driving but will remain in the Juniors or Novice Juniors class.</p> <p> Junior competitors who turn 18 during the season and still competing as a junior shall only pay junior entry fees for that season.</p>
TYRES	For Bitumen events tyres used are open but must not have canvas or steel showing. Spare tyres, which may be used during the Event, shall be scrutinized along with the vehicle. Slick Tyres will change vehicle class to F in accordance with the 4H 3.1. 2.4.

VEHICLES WITHOUT WINDSCREENS	Drivers of vehicles without windscreens must wear appropriate eye-protection as per Motorsport Australia requirements and South Eastern Automobile Club Motorkhana Series 2026 Standing Regulations
EVENT COURSES	Courses to be chosen from the Motorkhana test book and may include tests from Victorian Motorkhana Appendix (15. Additional approved tests).
PASSENGERS	An inexperienced driver (including a junior) may carry an experienced passenger, or an experienced driver may carry a junior or inexperienced adult passenger for the purpose of instruction and guidance in State, multi-club or club level events. Approval must be given from the Clerk of the Course prior to any passenger entering a vehicle. Passengers must sign a "Passenger in Vehicle Disclaimer Form" (even if they are also a driver on the day). This Event will include a Motor Sport Passenger Ride Activity (MSPRA) which shall be run under and in accordance with the Motorsport Australia MSPRA Policy.
METHOD OF SCORING A handicap system will apply in 2026	The handicap for SEAC scoring is applied before any penalties and is as follows: Class A - 0.90 Class B - 0.88 Class C - 0.86 Class D - 0.84 Class E - 0.92 Class F - no handicap Juniors and Novice Juniors will be handicapped on the car they are driving but will remain in the junior or novice junior class Competitors will be scored on 4 out of the 5 events. Your worst round will be dropped at the end of the season if you competed in all rounds in the 2026 series
VARIATIONS TO MOTORKHANA REGULATIONS	(a) Clause 12.1 that deals with reversing after crossing a designated finish line, the penalty is changed to "plus five seconds". (b) Clause 12.1 that deals with penalties for "knocking a marker" is varied with the addition of the words "and significantly displaced from its original position" (c) Diagrams may be provided for each course.

INTEGRITY

Smoking (including e-cigarettes and vaping) and any naked flame is prohibited within 3 metres of any refuelling or defueling operation.

Motorsport Australia's National Integrity Framework and relevant Policies, including the Australian Anti-Doping Policy, Illicit Drugs in Sport (Safety Testing) Policy and the Alcohol Policy, apply to any activity sanctioned by Motorsport Australia.

Any participant including the holder of a Motorsport Australia Licence (or a Licence issued by another ASN) may be tested for the presence of alcohol, any drug or other banned substance. In addition to any penalty imposed by Motorsport Australia, a further penalty/s may be applied by Sport Integrity Australia.

Consumption of alcohol in any Reserved Area is prohibited until all Competition is concluded each day.
